Experience a book in a whole new way by joining us on our StoryWalk®. We have pages of a book scattered in windows of downtown Wheaton businesses for you to find. Get some exercise and read a book along the way!

HOW IT WORKS

- 1. Start at the library and find the first pages of the book (Hint: They are in the front windows of the library.)
- 2. Use the map on the back page to find and read the rest of the book. Each page of the book around downtown Wheaton also has a QR Code that can be scanned for access to the map.
- 3. Record the Spanish and English words you find at each set of pages on your scavenger hunt sheet and turn it in to the Youth Services Department at the library to be entered into a prize drawing. Or, you can fill out the online scavenger hunt form at wheatonlibrary.org/storywalk. One scavenger hunt entry per family per month.
- 4. All pages will be posted in the windows of the library and the businesses so the StoryWalk® can be done on any day at any time!
