 - Hands-On (participants interact with your presentation without taking something home)

Maker Day Guidelines:

- Presenter must be available Saturday, October 20, 2018 from 12:00 to 5:00 p.m.
- Presenter must have an interactive display demonstrating their skill, talent, hobby, etc.
- Presenter may not sell products or services at the event but may advertise through business cards, signs, etc. at their designated table or area
- Presenter may use food items in their presentation but no food for consumption

- Accepted presenters will be notified on Monday, August 13, 2018
- Event date: Saturday, October 20, 2018
 - Set up begins at 12:00 p.m.
 - Event opens to the public at 1:00 p.m. and ends at 4:00 p.m.
